Outside play gives the child the opportunity to explore the garden environment safely. They are encouraged to use the sand toys to create shapes and explore the tactile sensation of using sand. Water play allows the child to develop their gross motor skills with tipping, pouring and handling different water play resources. It is also sensory play with the child experiencing the sensation of playing with water and different objects.

Class crafts vary on each day. All are introduced and led by the class teacher. This allows the child to explore their creativity by experiencing a variety of media and materials to work with. It encourages the development of fine motor skills alongside sensory exploration.



Class play gives the child the opportunity to explore their environment and begin to make choices for themselves when choosing toys to play with. The class adults will guide and encourage the child to become more confident in their play, develop their social skills and get a sense of pleasure in successful use of the resources.

Soft gym is an environment where the child can run and jump in safety. It gives them confidence to try new experiences for themselves. They also learn to be aware of other children while moving around and begin to develop their sense of space. The child can interact in a positive way with their carer who can help them to develop new games with the equipment available.



Children are shown the importance of hygiene while preparing for snack through hand washing before eating. They are introduced to the routine of sitting down to eat and of being part of a group to do this.

The toddler group is a safe, caring environment in which the children are introduced to the skills they will use upon entering school.

The teaching staff will lead the classes and will guide accompanying adults to allow the child to maximize their learning experience.



There is an expectation that the accompanying adult fully participates in supporting their child's exploration of the areas being used.

The session is run twice a week from 1.00pm to 2.30pm by a teacher and an assistant and is conducted in English. We ask that you have one adult per child to ensure that the child becomes familiar with and therefore confident in a new environment and is able to interact fully with the class team.
